**3 cups cold milk**

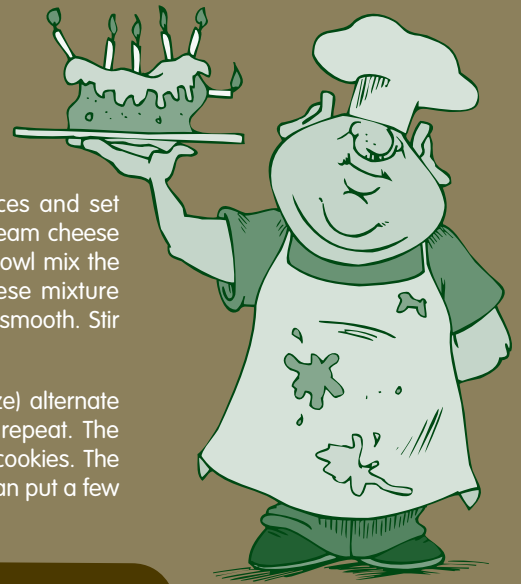
**1 large carton of Cool Whip (12 oz)**

**1 bag of gummy worms**

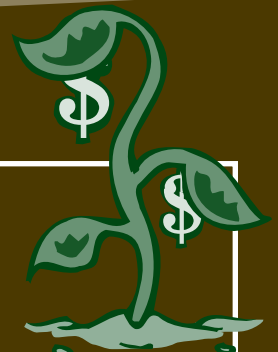
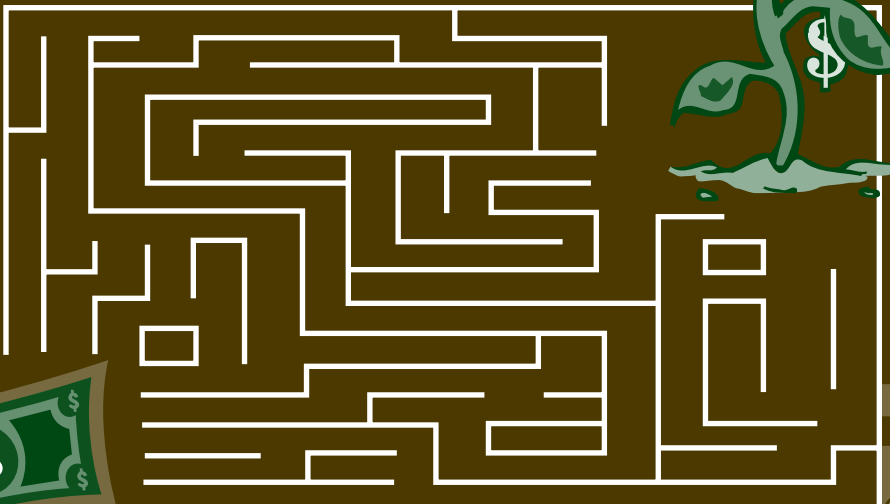
