



## FREE PRESCRIPTION DISCOUNT CARD!

Kitsap County has recently launched a discount prescription card program to help consumers cope with the rising costs of prescription drugs. These free cards are part of a national program sponsored by the National Association of Counties (NaCo), and offer average savings of 20% on the retail price of most commonly prescribed drugs. The card offers significant savings for those residents who may be uninsured or underinsured and living within kitsap county. The card may also benefit those residents with prescription coverage to cover drugs that may not be covered under their current health plan.

All residents may use the card regardless of age, income or existing medical coverage and are accepted at 95% of all the county's pharmacies. To use the card, just present it at a participating pharmacy. Cardholders and their families may use the card any time, with no restrictions or limits on frequency of use for their prescriptions that are not covered by insurance. The first play was staged in 1634 and has been performed once every 10 years since then. People must live in Oberammergau to be in the play and begin growing their beards and making costumes two years prior to the curtain.
