## Quimper Merger Update

As you may know, Kitsap Credit Union welcomed Quimper Community Federal Credit Union members to our family through a merger that was finalized on November 1, 2012. Though our financial data was consolidated as of this date, we have maintained two separate computer systems as we prepare for an eventual integration of the two. We will migrate all former Quimper members to the Kitsap Credit Union computer system on June 1, 2013.

We anticipate a smooth transition with minimal service interruptions. However, we know there will be some

brief and temporary interruptions in service on integration weekend, for example branches normally open on Saturdays may need to close for a partial or full day on June 1st to allow



for the computer system migration.

We are committed to providing you with detailed information about how the integration may affect you. In the coming weeks, we'll communicate important information through this newsletter, our website, online banking sites, statement messages, and mailings to impacted members, including a detailed integration guide for Quimper members that will be mailed in early May.

Kitsap Credit Union employees developed a peer recognition program called On the Spot.
